## WHAT TO BRING

- **TICKETS!** A valid event ticket and accessible parking ticket (permit required) if you have purchased one of these too, must be presented to enter event and accessible parking areas. Please have your tickets ready upon arrival for scanning by event staff, either printed or available to scan on your smart phone
- **NO Ticket | NO Entry | NO Exceptions**
- A chair or picnic rug – plan for not having access to seating.

- An **empty** reusable water bottle – there will be free water tanks onsite
- Dress warm – it is winter after all
- If inclement/wet weather to wear appropriate footwear for muddy/slippery conditions.

## WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Strictly **NO BYO** food or alcohol. This is to support the local vendors catering and provide safe responsible service of alcohol (RSA).
- All bags are subject to inspection upon entry and any items not permitted will be confiscated by security.
- NO pets allowed on site during the event

## WILL THERE BE FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICES?

- Food Vans will be operating for the duration of the event from 4pm – 10pm
- A bar will also be operating during the event. 18+ attendees will receive a wrist band on entry to access the bar. When ordering alcohol, you must follow all instructions from bar staff, and, if you are deemed to be intoxicated or are behaving irresponsibly, you may be refused service. Please note event goers are not able to take alcohol out of the event area.
- Food and beverage vendors may accept cash and/or EFTPOS payments; please come prepared for either option
- Please note there will be no ATM facilities on site at the event

## SECURITY AND ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

- Frost and Fire is supervised by a team of security professionals for your safety and enjoyment.
- Frost and Fire operates a Zero Tolerance policy. We reserve the right to have bags and other items be inspected by security staff. Persons who refuse bag searches WILL be denied entry or evicted from Frost and Fire without any refund.

## TRAVELLING BY PERSONAL VEHICLE

- Accessible Parking is limited to the designated area (permit required), and entry to the parking area will only be permitted with a valid ticket. Have your parking ticket ready at the gate to be checked by event staff. Refer to the [site map](#) for the accessible parking area location
- Disability Parking Permits must be displayed and will be checked by event staff for entry to Accessible Parking
- If you do not hold a valid parking ticket, you will be turned away from the parking area and you will be asked to return to one of the bus locations to catch the shuttle service (more info below) or park elsewhere off site.
- Roadside parking on Bedgerabong Road is not permitted for safety reasons
- Please follow directions of onsite attendants/staff at all times

## FREE BUS SERVICE

- FREE shuttle bus services will be operating to and from the event throughout the evening departing the following locations:
  - Loomzy's Fish n Fix, Corner of Farnell Street and Johnson Street
  - Forbes Town Hall, Harold Street
  - Apex Caravan Park, 88 Reymond Street
  - Big 4 Caravan Park (Forbes Holiday Park), 141 Flint Street
  - River Meadows Caravan Park, 10 River Road
  - Goldridge Estate (Roundabout), Federation Boulevard
  - Forbes High School, Calarie Road Bus Shelter
  - Forbes Golf Club, 17 Parkes Road
  - Club Forbes, Templar Street
  - Show Ground, Show Street Main Entrance
  - Lake Forbes Motel, 8 Junction Street
- The buses, including DA Compliant (accessible) buses will be running from 3:30pm with the last service leaving the event at 11pm. **Please refer to the full bus timetable below for the expected arrival times for your bus stop.**
- Tickets for the buses are not essential but are preferred for numbers.
- The designated drop off and pick-up area at the event is inside the main gate entry to the Ski Dam (please refer to the event [site map](#)) and follow the direction of staff

## TRAVELLING BY TAXI / GETTING DROPPED OFF

- If you require a taxi, call Forbes Taxi Service on 02 6852 2222
- The designated drop off and pick-up area for the event, is inside the main gate entry to the Ski Dam (please refer to the event [site map](#))
- Guests being dropped off and picked up by car/taxi should use this entry (which is also the bus entry). Please be mindful of these scheduled buses.
- For safety reasons, guests should **not** be dropped off on the side of the road outside the event area
- Taxis are expected to be in demand so keep this in mind for drop off and pick up

## WALKING TO THE EVENT

- Guests arriving at the event on foot should use the walking path provided. Walking along the roadside is not permitted for safety reasons

## EVENT CONSIDERATIONS:

- **Sensory Overload:** Frost and Fire is an inclusive event; we recognise that there are persons who are affected/overwhelmed by loud music. If at any time you feel you need to relocate to a quiet space - a quiet area will be located at the merchandise tent. (please refer to the event [site map](#))
- **Event noise:** Please be mindful when departing this event that the surrounding area is residential. We ask all event goers to be considerate of our neighbours.
- **Waste Management:** Please be advised that we have provided a significant number of event bins, including designated recycling bins, for your use. Please ensure you put your rubbish in the bin and recycle where possible.

## FIRST AID

- There will be a first aid tent on site located near the toilet block (please refer to the event [site map](#))

## LOST CHILDREN / LOST AND FOUND

- Please notify event staff/emergency services personnel if a child is lost and an announcement will be made. Event staff will be wearing hi-vis and event staff lanyards to be easily identifiable, otherwise please locate the merchandise tent and notify the rostered-on staff.
